In those instances where course or curriculum material is controversial, it is the intent of the College that within the parameters of the 1968 NEA Code of Ethics and the 1940 AAUP Statement of Principles on Academic Freedom and tenure, faculty be free to teach the truth of their discipline as they see it, present alternative points of view and provide students with freedom to challenge and question.
