The following Finance Committee items are recommended to the Ocean County College Board of Trustees for approval at its meeting on **Thursday**, **January 23**, **2025**:

- 2. Recommend that the following contracts be awarded:
 - a. For general contractor construction services for a new Administration Building at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-2)
 - b. For general contractor construction services for the Grunin Center Lobby Expansion project at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-3)
- 3. Recommend adoption of resolutions to award the following contracts:
 - a. For an eleven-month contract from January 23, 2025, through December 31, 2025, for the purchase of Student Recovery Support Program online certification courses for full-time and adjunct instructors at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-4)
 - b. For the preparation and issuance of IRS 1098-T forms to students at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-5)
 - c. For the purchase of snow removal and salting materials for use by the Facilities Department at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-6)

- d. For the first year of a three-year agreement from December 13, 2024, through December 12, 2025, for the renewal of the VMware Licensing software for use at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-7)
- e. For the purchase of an Analog Voice Gateway for the voice over IP system at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-8)
- f. For the purchase of Chromebooks for students who are in need through the Bond Act, as part of the Library Modernization Project at Ocean County College (**Exhibit A-9**)
- g. For a twelve-month agreement for street sweeping services from January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2025, at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-10)
- h. For a three-year license renewal and technical support from February 27, 2025, through February 26, 2028, of the CommVault software subscription through the NJEdge.net Consortium at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-11)
- i. For a one-year contract from March 1, 2025, through February 28, 2026, for the renewal of the Microsoft Software Campus Volume License Agreement through the NJEdge Microsoft Licensing Consortium for use by the Office of Information Technology at Ocean County College (Exhibit A-12)
- 4. Recommend that the following contracts be amended:
 - a. An additional \$2,175, for a maximum total of \$18,817.27, to Aspire Technology Partners, LLC, Eatontown, New Jersey, for additional audio/visual services and various equipment for the Library Modernization Project at Ocean County College (initial contract was under threshold and did not require Board approval) (Exhibit A-13)
 - b. An additional \$9,920, for a maximum total of \$25,851, to Daktronics, Brookings, South Dakota, for the professional installation of two athletic scoreboards at Ocean County College ((initial contract was under threshold and did not require Board approval) (Exhibit A-14)
 - c. An additional \$24,000, for a maximum total of \$59,000, to CB Education Consulting, LLC, Freehold, New Jersey, for additional Dental Hygiene Program Consultant Services at Ocean County College (contract originally awarded at the November 7, 2024, Board meeting) (**Exhibit A-15**)

- d. An additional \$23,109.41, for a maximum total of \$1,668,900, to G Meyer Group, Manasquan, New Jersey, for removal and/or modification of existing piping and ducts as part of the Grunin Center Music Practice Room renovation project at Ocean County College (contract originally awarded at the November 7, 2024, Board meeting) (Exhibit A-16)
- e. An additional \$14,300, for a maximum total of \$30,100, to Shade Environmental, LLC, Maple Shade, New Jersey, for professional asbestos abatement services for the Grunin Center Music Practice Room project through the Hunterdon County Educational Services Commission (HCESC) cooperative contract at Ocean County College (initial contract was under threshold and did not require Board approval) (Exhibit A-17)
- 5. Recommend the following contracts be rescinded:
 - a. The contract awarded at the November 7, 2024, Board meeting, to SHI International Corporation, Somerset, New Jersey, as the vendor notified the College after the award that the quote had expired and they were unable or unwilling to extend. A new agreement through the NJEdge Consortium Contract is to be awarded to the same vendor under new quote (Exhibit A-18)
 - b. The contract awarded at the November 7, 2024, Board meeting, to National Asbestos and Environmental Training Institute, Inc., Mine Hill, New Jersey, due to repeated delays and non-fulfillment of services by the vendor as outlined in the agreement. The vendor has been notified in writing of the termination of the aforementioned agreement (Exhibit A-19)
- 6. Recommend acceptance of a \$5,742,966 SCCT5 Grant (Strengthening Community College Training) over 4 years, with OCC to receive \$2,835,868 over 4 years, for the Health First New Jersey (HFNJ), a consortium of Ocean County College (OCC), Middlesex College (MC), and Atlantic Cape Community College (ACCC), led by OCC, to increase the number of highly skilled healthcare workers in the region's healthcare and healthcare information technology (IT) industry sector, providing guided career pathways aligned to employment data from the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development (NJDOL). The project's geographic scope includes four (4) New Jersey counties (Atlantic, Cape May, Middlesex, and Ocean) and 97 municipalities. Project Manager: Dr. Joseph Konopka, Vice President, Workforce Development and Strategic Partnerships. Funding Period: February 1, 2025, through January 31, 2029.



7. Recommend adoption of a resolution approving and authorizing a modification of the original awarded project as approved by the Office of the Secretary of Higher Education for an expansion of our original Securing our Children's Future Bond Act project and program capacity to include outfitting space in our library so that students in Graphic Design, Electronic Media, Supply Chain, Data Analytics, Artificial Intelligence, and Cybersecurity can access the same laboratory supplies for hands-on learning and studying outside their classroom hours to increase retention and completion of these CTE programs; authorizing the financing of all or a portion of the Project through program(s) made available by the State of New Jersey for New Jersey institutions of higher education and other available funding sources; approving and authorizing the form of the application to the Secretary of Higher Education; approving and authorizing the execution and delivery of any and all agreements in connection with undertaking, implementing, and financing the Project in the form(s) approved by the officers of the institution executing such agreement(s); and designating and authorizing the officers of the institution to take the aforementioned actions and to take any and all such other actions deemed necessary or desirable to undertake, implement, and finance the Project(s). WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Ocean County College recognizes the need to purchase online certification courses for full-time and adjunct instructors at Ocean County College. The courses will empower instructors to create more active and engaging classes leading to decreases in DFW rates and increases in student retention; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Ocean County College has a need to acquire goods and services which are exempt from bidding pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 18A:64A-25.5a.(15) et seq. professional consulting services; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Vice President of Finance of Ocean County College has determined and certified in writing that the value of the acquisition will exceed \$17,500; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.4, a Certificate has been provided by the Executive Vice President of Finance of Ocean County College, stating that funds are available for this purpose, which certificate is attached to the original of this resolution and is on file in the office of the Executive Vice President of Finance; and

WHEREAS, the vendor has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies it has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the County of Ocean the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract; and

WHEREAS, Ocean County College wishes to award a required disclosure contract in compliance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 and without the need for public bidding in compliance with the provisions of County College Contracts Law, N.J.S.A.18A:64A-25.1 et seq.;

WHEREAS: The Board of Trustees (the "Board") of Ocean County College (the "Institution") desires to approve the undertaking, implementation, and financing of the Project (the "Project") consisting of (1) the renovation of the existing Ocean County College Technology Building and (2) the installation of classroom technology upgrades and related technology infrastructure improvements; and

WHEREAS: The Board desires to approve the costs of the Project to be paid and/or financed through all sources in an amount not to exceed \$1,206,475; and

WHEREAS: The Board desires to finance the Project through the hereinafter defined Program made available by the State of New Jersey (the "State") for certain projects of New Jersey institutions of higher education (the "Program"); and

WHEREAS: The State Program is the Securing Our Children's Future Bond Act P.L. 2018, c. 119; and

WHEREAS: The Board has determined that the Project will assist in serving the needs of its students and in providing a benefit to the Institution; and

WHEREAS: The Board desires to approve financing of the Project through the State Program; and

WHEREAS: The Board wishes to approve the form of the Application to be submitted to the Secretary of Higher Education (the "Secretary") for the Proposed Program for the Project and to designate the authorized officers of the Institution to take all necessary and desirable actions required to undertake, implement, and submit to the Secretary the Application for the Project; and

WHEREAS: The Board hereby approves the Master Plan of the Institution in the form attached hereto as Exhibit OCC-A and authorizes and directs the officers designated in this Resolution to include the Master Plan in the Application approved herein; and

WHEREAS: The Board reasonably expects to reimburse expenditures for the costs of the Project paid prior to issuance of Tax-Exempt Bonds or any debt-bearing interest which is exempt from gross income for federal income tax purposes which will fund an applicable Project and/or Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF OCEAN COUNTY COLLEGE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Board approves the Project and authorizes the undertaking, implementation, and financing of the Project in a maximum aggregate amount not to exceed \$1,206,475. The Board further approves the Master Plan of the Institution in the form attached hereto as Exhibit OCC-A.

SECTION 2. The Board approves the financing of all or any portion of the Project through the State Programs identified above. The Board approves the Application for funding of the Project through such Programs in the form submitted to the Board and authorizes and directs the herein defined Designated Officers to submit such Application to the Secretary with such changes, modifications, and additions as shall be conclusively evidenced by the submission of the Application to the Secretary. The Board expressly directs and authorizes the Designated Officers to submit the Long-Range Capital Plan in the Application for any Program for which it is required. The Board acknowledges and agrees that approval of the Application and receipt of funds pursuant to the State Program(s) will obligate the Institution to: (a) provide funds for the operation and maintenance of the Project, (b) contribute to the cost of the Project,

(c) pay all or a portion of debt service on Tax-Exempt Bonds issued to fund the Proposed Program(s) as applicable, and (d) fulfill other conditions imposed under the State Program(s) and hereby directs and authorizes the Designated Officers to certify such acknowledgement and agreement as part of the submitted Application. The Designated Officers are hereby authorized and directed to fulfill all conditions of the Proposed Program(s) including, without limitation, providing for the operation and maintenance of the Project and using available funds of the Institution to pay for such operation and maintenance and to satisfy conditions of the Proposed Program(s) to contribute to the cost of Project and/or debt service on Tax-Exempt Bonds issued to fund the Proposed Program(s) from available funds of the Institution.

SECTION 3. The President and Executive Vice President of Finance and Administration (each an "Authorized Officer") are each hereby authorized and directed to approve, execute,

and deliver any and all agreements necessary to undertake, implement, and finance the Project and any and all other financing documents and instruments in the form approved by the Authorized Officers executing the same in the name of and on behalf of the Board of the Institution, in as many counterparts as may be necessary, and to affix or impress the official seal of the Institution thereon and to attest the same and such execution and attestation will be conclusive evidence of the approval in the form and content of such agreements and other documents and instruments necessary to undertake, implement, and finance the Project and to pay Financing Costs including through the financing thereof.
