WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT AND STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIPS Highlights

- Served a total of 532 students in ESL programs.
- 110 students in the ESL Program have also taken additional Workplace Literacy courses.
- Developed a partnership with 11 Ocean County high schools to educate them on certificate and credential programs for students who have indicated they do not want to attend college.
- Year 1 of 3 of the Delta Dental SMILES Grant: scholarship opportunities for future Dental Assistants, new educational equipment and supplies, and technology that will increase employment opportunities for the students.

- Feb. 2025: Piloting the Center for Adult Transitioning (CAT) Grant Program for first cohort of students 18-24 with intellectual and developmental disabilities to provide workplace readiness opportunities.
- Feb. 2025: Patient Care Technician Program with cohort of 10 students on scholarship through the Pathways Program.
- Dec. 2024: Launched the Project Management Program with Pathway Program scholarship opportunity for 30 students to take the Google Project Management program, earning them 6 certifications from Google and a credential as a Google Project Management Specialist. Once completed, the students will take PMP or CAPM prep course and sit for either the PMP or CAPM National Certification Exam.

Adult Education, Civics and Workforce Preparation Program (AECWP/Title II).

- FY24-25 enrolled 395 students (summer & fall terms) with a 99.2% retention rate.
- Embedded dog therapy visit days into the Work Readiness Assistance Program (WRAP).
- Provided fiscal literary workshop.
- Held holiday party for all ESL students.
- Continue to enhance literacy within families by providing Family Literacy events with OCC and the county libraries.
- Provided guest speakers or field trips to explore over 15 different careers.
